After brushing a tear from her cheek, she said, "This is

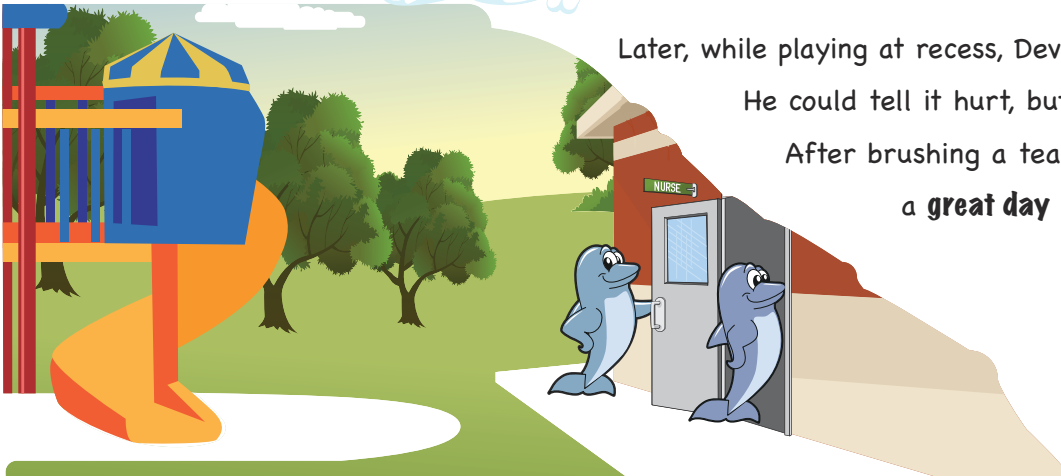
a **great day** to be a **dolphin**." Then a girl named

Darcy came up to her and said,

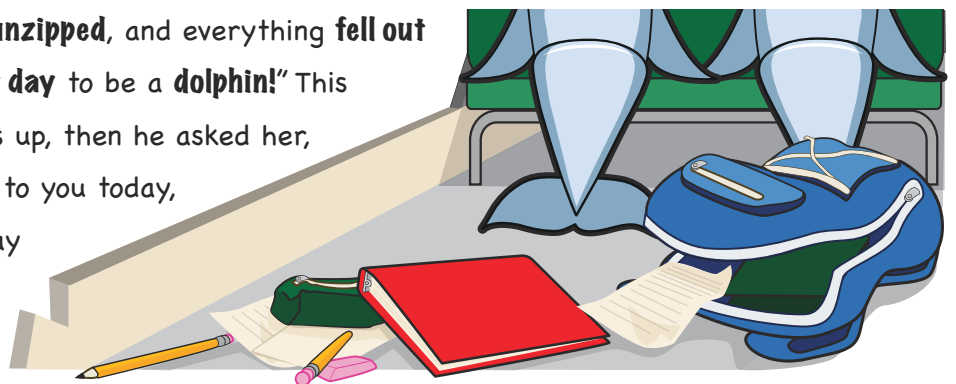
"You should get a **bandaid** on that.
